SUBMISSION TYPES:

ICHITA and IT Forum are very well attended by participants and presenters from the industry and academics. Authors from the following categories (but not limited to) are invited to submit original contributions (written in English) in PDF format. Only original papers not published or submitted for publication elsewhere can be submitted. Submissions can be abstract (one page), full length paper (up to 9 pages) or a case study (up to 9 pages). Upon acceptance, at least one author is required to register for the conference.

- Industry Industry experience and position papers.
- Academic Academic research papers (Applied/ Theoretical).
- Students Graduate and undergraduate students, with the approval of their advisor, are invited to submit papers or posters. All student team members are welcome to register for the conference and participate in presentations.

SUBMISSION FOR REFEREED PAPERS, POSTERS, CASE STUDIES AND DEMONSTRATIONS:

Full paper submissions will undergo a double-blind review process. At least one of the authors of the accepted paper must register to attend the conference. If accepted, referee papers will be published in the conference proceedings and will be scheduled for presentation during the concurrent presentation sessions. Acceptance of abstracts and papers are subject to final approval by the track chairs.
