These Critical Languages are open to <u>special students</u>, <u>sophomores</u>, <u>juniors</u>, <u>seniors</u>, and <u>graduate students</u>. They may be taken for <u>credit</u> (4 semester hours), audit, or pass/fail.

One Critical Language may be used to satisfy the Liberal Arts Curriculum <u>Foreign</u> <u>Language Requirement</u> (12 semester hours). The Linguistics Department also offers an <u>undergraduate minor in Hindi-Urdu</u> (20 semester hours).

Prospective Critical Languages students must be enrolled for the Fall Semester (advance registration--May 20-22, June 29-July 31) and must secure a 'control card' from the secretary of the Linguistics Department, 4th floor Sprau Tower (or call 383-0064).
