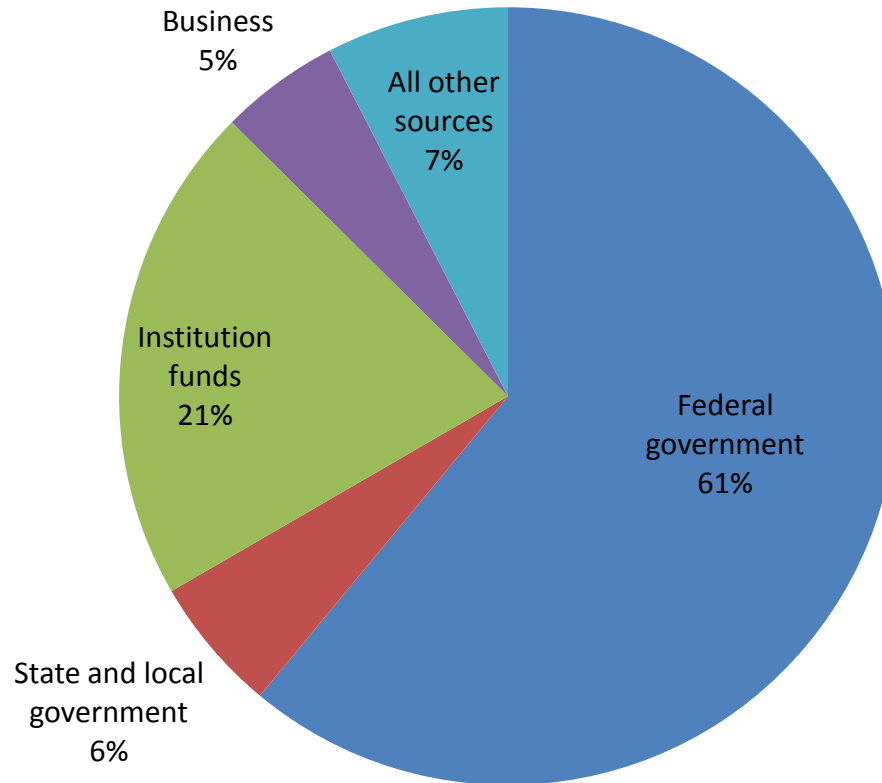

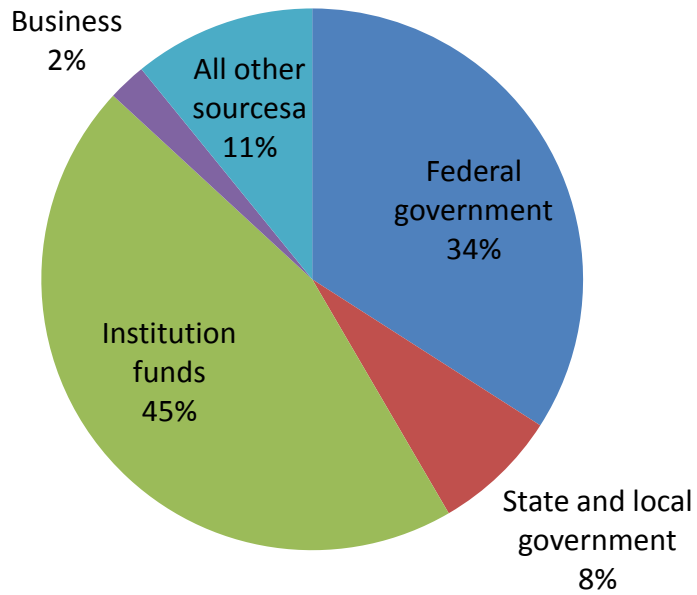
R&D Expenditures at universities and colleges by source of funds (FY 2012)



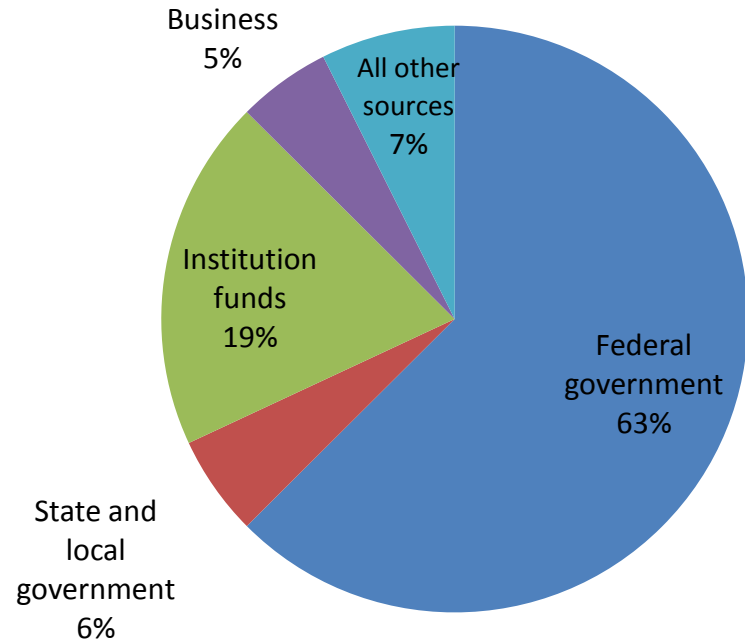
