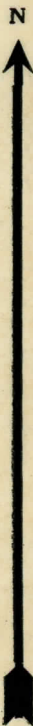
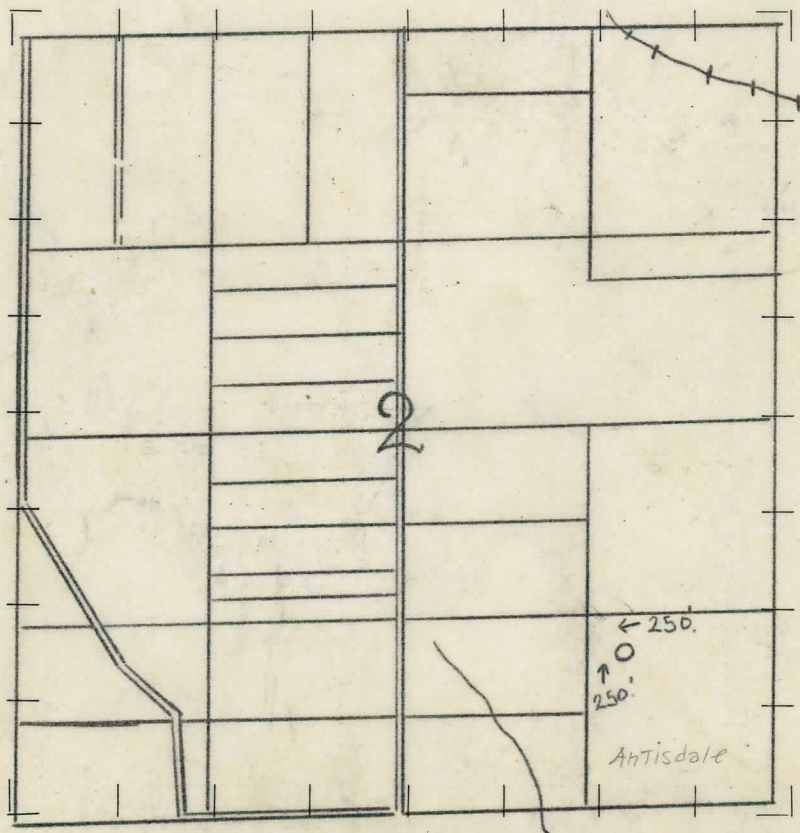

The well in which you are in doubt about the location was drilled under Permit No. 113 issued to S. B. Ridenour for the William Antisdale #1 in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 2, T.9N., R.17W. This is definitely in T.17W. as Mr. Bill Daoust definitely remembers the plugging of this well. It seems that when the well was plugged the operations were carried on a little too fast with the result that a bailer was hung up and lost in the hole.

The Daily Crude Oil Company's Hansen #1 in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 10, T.12N., R.6W., was abandoned as a producer on May 14, 1941. It is now being used as a brine disposal well.

We trust this is the information you desire.
