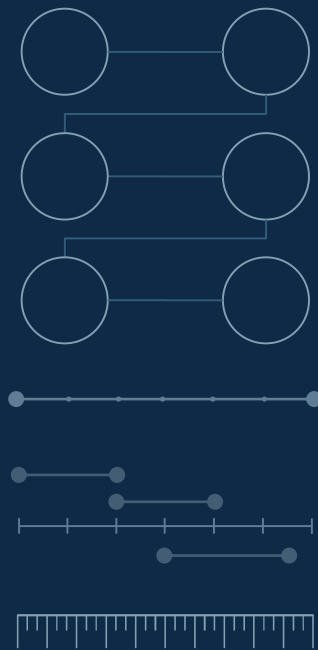
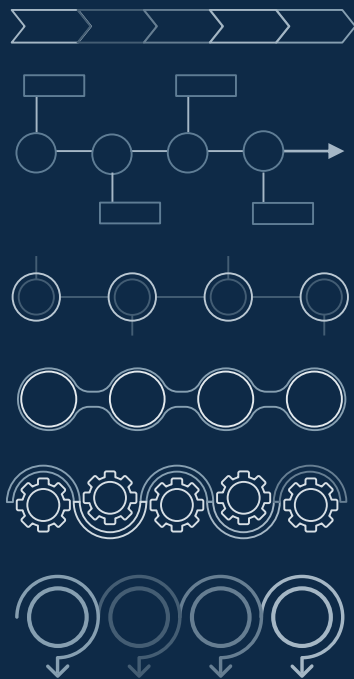
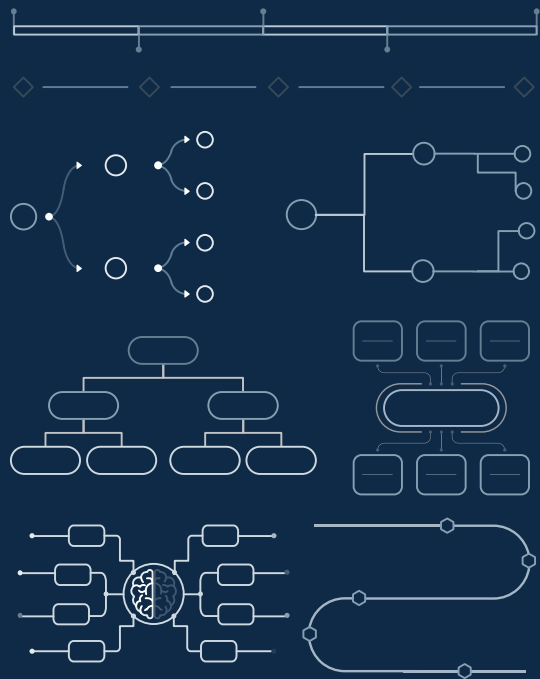
Use our editable graphic resources...
