My name is Jenna McKellips, and I am a PhD student and researcher at the University of Toronto. I recently wrote a paper on the use of female imagery within Hildegard's *Scivias*, and the paper was accepted for future publication by the *Medieval Feminist Forum*. I'd like to include a few images from the *Scivias* facsimile miniatures in your collection when the paper is published, if possible. What is the process for using the miniature images in publication, and how much does the monastery charge per image?
